What do you seek? John 1:35-39
Big Idea: Eternal life is more that living forever, it is the fullness of life in union with God, through Christ that goes on forever. And the degree to which we possess and experience that, today, in THIS LIFE, hangs heavily on one question: What do you seek?
I. John's purpose for writing his gospel.
II. <b>Zóé</b> is about the substance or quality of the life we have. A life characterized as Zoe would not only <u>see</u> their life through the divine lens, but <u>seeks</u> to use that life as a tool primarily to bring God glory. A life of Zoe thrives in the divine dance which brings God's kingdom to bear in this life, seeing each moment of their life as a moment on the stage in the theater of Heaven to reveal God's glory <u>and finds its greatest joy and satisfaction in the accomplishment of that.</u>
